AGE GROUP

COST PER LEARNER

R16,000 all inclusive for **10 days**
(departing Cape Town)

Rates adjusted depending on point of departure.

Shorter or longer stays can happily be arranged from anywhere in Southern Africa.

For every 8 learners a teacher is hosted for free

- Return flights Cape Town to Johannesburg
