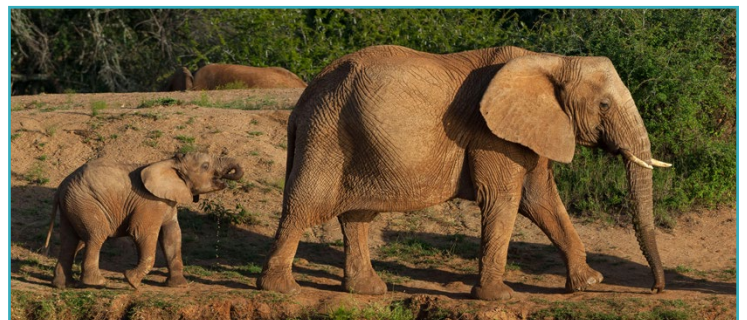
**Plan A:** Botswana (Tuli Block) - depending on travel restrictions and border openings. Flights to Lanseria Airport. [Click here for more information](#)
